The following pages provide information on the secondary and primary schools allocated places from the NCTL (National College for Teaching and Leadership) for the following training programmes:

- ❖ School Direct Training Programme (salaried) – employed by the school
- ❖ School Direct Training Programme (tuition fee) – Bursary paid to eligible trainees
- ❖ SCITT – School Centred Initial Teacher Training

Bromley Schools' Collegiate will be responsible for the administration of all applications

School-led training courses give you the chance to learn 'on the job' in a school. You work as part of the teaching team from day one – similar to student medics in hospitals – learning from experienced, teachers and immediately putting your new skills into practice.

Check you have the following entry requirements:

- **UK Degree (or Equivalent) 2.1 or above (consideration will be given to those with 2.2)**
- **GCSE English and Maths grade C or above for Secondary + GCSE Science grade C or above (for Primary)**
- **Pass both Numeracy and Literacy Professional Skills tests *before* the start of the course in September 2016**
- **Good subject knowledge for teaching secondary (your degree should be at least 50% of the subject you wish to teach)**
- **School Direct Training Programme (salaried) - It is an entry requirement candidates have 3 years work experience (with exception to some priority subjects at the discretion of the school / provider)**

If selected for interview you will be asked if you are able to travel between the schools for the training programme offered by BSC – you may need to relocate for the year.

In Apply 1 you can to make up to three choices.

- Competition for places can be strong, so think about how's best to use your choices.
- You don't have to use all three, but if you do, you have to make them at the same time – you can't add them later in Apply 1.
- There's no restriction to your three choices – you can choose from any route, subject or age group, in any combination

How it works

You only use Apply 2 if you didn't get a place in Apply 1 or you declined your offers.

- In Apply 2 you can make one choice at a time.
- You'll be able to make an unlimited number of additional choices, one by one.

Training Bursaries

Trainees who are offered a place on **SCITT** or **School Direct Training** programmes may be eligible to receive bursary payments. The amount will vary depending on teacher training subject and degree class or highest relevant academic qualification.

Teaching is a prime career choice for high-quality graduates, and we are looking for excellent graduates wanting to train to teach secondary subjects and primary. To encourage the best people to enter the profession, larger financial incentives are offered to trainees with 2:1 and first class degrees. The bursary scheme recognises exceptional achievement outside of degree results and allows flexibility in some cases. In exceptional circumstances trainees may receive a higher bursary than their degree class would otherwise allow. This allows the scheme to take account of, for example, trainees with a 2:2 and a PhD or proven exceptional subject knowledge gained from another career.

Tuition fee loan

If you are on a postgraduate ITT course which is not salaried, you will have to pay tuition fees. Tuition fees vary depending on the course and the higher education institution (HEI) or SCITT provider. Bromley Schools' Collegiate tuition fee is £9000, this includes the PGCE element of the course (we pay Canterbury Christchurch University) and QTS (Qualified Teacher Status).

Home and EU students may be eligible for a tuition fee loan to cover the cost of tuition fees charged. This is available through [Student Finance England](#)

School Direct Salaried trainees are employed by the school, subject to staff terms and conditions. If you are a graduate with around three years work experience the employment based route could be the course for you, as you will earn a salary during your training year. The course leads to Qualified Teacher Status (QTS). The training fee will be met by the school. BSC will give you the opportunity to register for the PGCE accredited by Canterbury Christ Church University. The cost will be met by the trainee (currently £1,850).

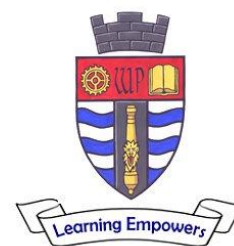
