What is the purpose?

Following the success of the TSST French course run in 2016-17, we are pleased to offer the course again this academic year. This course is designed to develop the subject knowledge of qualified teachers **who did not train as teachers in the MFL or wish to enhance their second MFL**. They are also suitable for **returning teachers** who need to refresh their subject knowledge. Darrick TSA is offering a series of twilight sessions to develop subject knowledge and pedagogy for KS3 French and prepare for KS4. There will be 12 sessions covering key areas needed to deliver successful MFL lessons. Included is the opportunity to observe lessons at DWS. This high quality INSET opportunity will be **free to teachers** and is funded by the government to enable schools to increase their capacity to deliver the EBacc subjects.

What are the benefits?

- Schools will extend their staffing capacity through training more MFL teachers
- Teachers will improve their skills through good pedagogic practice
